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NOTICE OF ADOPTION

VILLAGE OF PENN YAN

Local Law Amending Chapter 190, the "Vehicles and Traffic" Chapter of the Village Code.

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Penn Yan, County of Yates, State of New York, which was held on the 17th day of August, 2021, the above referenced proposed Local Law was adopted.

The effect of this Local Law will be to amend the Vehicles and Traffic Chapter of the Village Code for the safety of school children in school zones by uniformly setting school zone speed limits at 15 miles per hour..

Local Law 8 of 2021 Amending Chapter 190, the “Vehicles and Traffic” of the Code of the Village of Penn Yan.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Penn Yan, in the County of Yates, as follows:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE

This Local Law shall be known as the “School Zone Speed Limit Amendment of the Vehicles and Traffic Chapter For 2021.”

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT

The Board of Trustees determines that for the safety of school children in school zones and for uniformity of school zone speed limits those limits should all be set at 15 miles per hour and that the Vehicles and Traffic Chapter of the Village Code be so amended.

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 4. PROVISIONS

The following Section of Chapter 190, “Vehicles and Traffic” is amended as set forth herein:

- I. Chapter 190. “Vehicles and Traffic” is amended by setting the speed limits in school zones pursuant to §190.39. Schedule III: “School Speed Limits” as provided herein:

CHAPTER 190. Vehicles and Traffic

Article VI. Schedules

§ 190-39. Schedule III: School Speed Limits.

In accordance with the provisions of § 190-6, no person shall drive a vehicle in excess of the speeds indicated below, in the areas designated below, during school days and hours listed below:

Name of Street:	Speed Limit (mph)	Location and Time:
Court Street	15	On Court Street west of westerly street line of Liberty Street to the easterly street line of Highland Drive from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Keuka Street	15	On Keuka Street north of the northerly street line of Elm Street to the southerly street line of Chapel Street from 7a.m. to 6 p.m.
Keuka Street	15	On Keuka Street north of the southerly street line of Chapel Street to the southerly street line of Court Street from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Liberty Street	15	On Liberty Street north of the northerly street line of Court Street to the north property line of premises known as 530 Liberty Street anytime the school zone beacons are flashing.
Main Street	15	On Main Street north of the northerly street line of Court Street to the northerly street line of Mill Street school days between the hours of 7 AM to 9 AM and 2 PM to 4 PM
Davis Street	15	Entire length of street from 7a.m. to 6 p.m.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York, subsequent to having been duly adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Penn Yan.


