Proposed Local Law Regarding Parking, Standing and Stopping on Maiden Lane.

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Penn Yan, County of Yates, State of New York, will be held at the Village Hall, 111 Elm Street, Penn Yan, New York, on the 20th day of May, 2025, at 6:15 p.m. upon the proposed Local Law.

The effect of this Local Law will be to adopt provisions regarding parking, standing and stopping on Maiden Lane.

All persons interested in this proposed Local Law will be heard by the Board of Trustees at the Public Hearing to be held as stated above. Written comments may be submitted to the Village Clerk's Office in person or by US mail at 111 Elm Street, Penn Yan, NY 14527. Such comments must be received no later than 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Tuesday, May 20, 2025. Copies of the proposed Local Law are available at the Office of the Clerk of the Village of Penn Yan, 111 Elm Street, Penn Yan, NY 14527 during regular business hours.

Proposed Local Law J of 2025 Amending Chapter 190, “Vehicles and Traffic” of the Code of the Village of Penn Yan.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Penn Yan, in the County of Yates, as follows:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE

This Local Law shall be known as the “Maiden Lane Parking, Standing and Stopping Regulations Amendment of the Vehicle and Traffic Chapter For 2025.”

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT

The Board of Trustees determines that due to the narrow structure of Maiden Lane delivery vehicles which are parked, standing or stopped thereon block traffic flow along Maiden Lane creating traffic hazards. Accordingly the Vehicle and Traffic Chapter should be amended to address that matter.

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 4. PROVISIONS

The following Sections of Chapter 190, “Vehicles and Traffic” are amended as set forth herein:

I. The following items of §190-48 “Schedule XII: “Parking Prohibited at All Times” of Article VI “Schedules” are repealed:

| 1. Maiden Lane | South | From the intersection of the Centerline of Rte. 14A for a distance of 254 feet east. |
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2. Maiden Lane	South	From the intersection of the west curbline of Main Street for a distance of 198 feet west.
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II. The following is added to Section 190-49 “Schedule XIII: “No Stopping”:

Maiden Lane	Both sides and center of Street	Entire length of Maiden Lane from the east curb of Rte. 14A, Liberty Street, easterly to the west curb of Main Street at any time. Exceptions are for mailbox deposits in the USPS box at The Firehouse Ave. intersection and brief garbage pickups.
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III. The following is added to Section 190-49 “Schedule XIV: “No Standing”:

Maiden Lane	Both sides and center of Street	Entire length of Maiden Lane from the east curb of Rte. 14A, Liberty Street, easterly to the west curb of Main Street, at any time.
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SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York, subsequent to having been duly adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Penn Yan.
