Information Collected When You Visit this Website:

When visiting this website, the Village automatically collects and stores the following information about your visit:

The Internet Protocol address and domain name of your Internet service provider.

Information Collected When You Submit a Form on this Website

Your email address and the information contained in your form will be used to respond to you, to address issues you identify, to communicate information to you, or to further improve this website. Your email address is not collected for commercial marketing purposes and the Village does not sell or distribute your email address for commercial marketing purposes.

Personal Information:

"Personal information" is information about an individual (e.g. an individual's name, address, email address, and phone number). A domain name or Internet Protocol address is not considered personal information. Personal information is not collected through this website unless you submit a form to the Village through this website.
