Re: Pipe Lining of the Sanitary Sewer

Dear Residents;

The Village of Penn Yan has contracted with Kenyon Pipeline Inspection, LLC to reline the existing Sanitary Sewer along portions of Sunset Ave, Hillcrest Dr, Orchard Ln and Crescent Dr. This is part of the Village's ongoing efforts to reinvest in our infrastructure.

This work is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of August 28th. Once the contractor is on-site, they will be placing door hangers to inform the residents further of their daily work schedule.

### **How is this work performed?**

The contractor will use a flexible sock or liner similar in size to the existing sanitary sewer pipe. This material is flexible and impregnated with polyester resins. This material will be installed between manholes in the street. Once the liner is in place a steam curing process will be introduced to cure or harden the liner in place. The final operation is to then robotically reopen each household private sanitary lateral where it connects to the Villages Public Sanitary Sewer.

### **What does this mean for each Resident?**

There will be several trucks and personnel involved in this operation. Please be patient and the contractor should be accommodating as possible while still performing their work. If able, please refrain from large consumption of water such as long showers or multiple loads of wash the day Kenyon is working on your street.

Each private house lateral is connected to the Village Sanitary line. Under normal properly working plumbing conditions this will not have an impact on your residence. **However, if your house plumbing is not properly vented, odors may enter your residence. These will dissipate over time. Also, improper venting may cause back pressure in your sewer lateral and cause the water in your drains/traps to release into your home. To avoid this, please be sure to keep your toilet lids closed and place a towel over your sink drains while not in use to be safe.**

The village is acting proactively to inform its residents to eliminate any potential issues that may occur with an operation such as this. Should you have any questions or need assistance, please contact, myself or Brett McMichael, Deputy Director of Public Works at 315-279-6535.
